1. **Budget Work Session:** The Board discussed the budget for 2026. Clerk Duran let them know the cost of the ASPITS is \$205,000, the senior center grant is \$ 245,000, and the water conservation plan is \$60,000. Mayor VanWhy said he would also like \$75,000 for road base to due east main, Shaffer, and 3rd.
